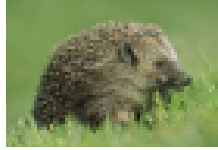

Maths

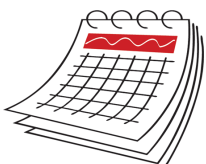
