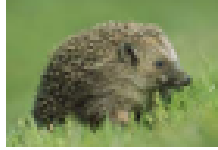

Next week we will be using the Bee-bots during our computing lesson. We will discuss giving a set of commands to our Bee-bots and talk about direction.
