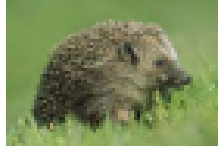





Amazing Animals

<p style="text-align: center;">Curriculum</p>	<p>After half term we are excited to meet farm animals. A Therapy Farm will be visiting on Wednesday and Friday. We will have the opportunity to stroke and learn about the following animals: goats, ducks, chickens, sheep, rabbits, and guinea pigs.</p> <p>At home you can..</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - draw and write about your favourite animal 
<p style="text-align: center;">English Communication and Language</p> 	<p>After half term we will write a report about our year in Reception. We will talk about our favourite topics and discuss things we are good at. We are continuing to practise writing simple sentences using capital letters and full stops. We are encouraging the children to use finger spaces so they can re-read what they have written.</p> <p>At home you can..</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - continue to practise writing words with digraphs ar or ur oi ow (park, fork surf coin crown) - Play buried treasure with a focus on your phase 3 digraphs <p>https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/3/buried-treasure</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> 	<p>After half term we will be exploring odd and even numbers. We will be learning through the use of numicons. If the numicon has an extra circle, or a friend missing, is it even or odd? We will link this to our learning about sharing amounts.</p> <p>At home you can.....</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Talk about odd and even numbers - Practice trying to share out even and odd numbers using household objects - If we can't share out equally or fairly, is the number odd or even?
