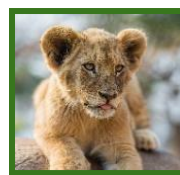
Growth and Creatures

Curriculum



We will be finding out about and naming parts of our bodies and animals bodies.

Literacy Communication and Language



We will read non-fiction books to inform us about our bodies and how we need to look after them.

We will learn how to label parts of the body.

We will think about some of the features of animal bodies which are different to our own.

Phonics



We will continue to revise **s a t p i n** and learn how to hear, say and write **m & d**.

Maths



We will revise 2D shapes and learn the names of 3D shapes. We will also see if we can spot 2D shapes on the 3D shapes.

Physical Development



Development of ongoing skills such as:

Start taking part in some group activities which they make up themselves, or in teams
Choose the right resources to carry out their own plan. E.g. choosing a spade to enlarge a small hole they dug with a trowel

Collaborate with others to manage large items, such as moving a long plank safely,
carrying large hollow blocks

Make healthy choices about food, drink, activity & tooth brushing

Bedding plants - if you have any spare bedding plants, which we could add to our garden beds and plant pots to add a splash of colour, we would be extremely grateful!

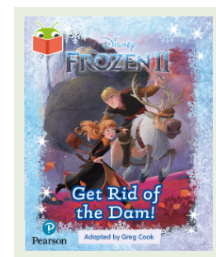
Learning at home
