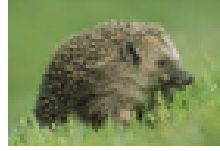






Next week we'll be continuing our exploration of capacity. We will focus on estimation and using the right vocabulary. eg. Full, half full and empty. Can we order these ?
