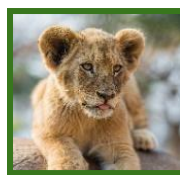

Curriculum 	We will continue to build buildings in our local community. Following our visit from Mr Roffe we will build a post office and post box to post our letters into.
Literacy Communication and Language 	We are continuing to practise singing songs for our 50th celebrations. You could practise singing the following song at home: https://www.youtubekids.com/watch?v=f8vn9dvqoYc&hl=en-GB
Phonics 	We will keep practising s a t p i n m d g o c k and ck and learn how to hear, say and write e & u
Maths 	Subitising: this is when children can quickly see an amount without counting. Rolling a dice at home is a good way to practise subitising. Next week we will build towers and we will ask the children to show us with their fingers how many bricks they can see.
Physical Development 	<u>Development of ongoing skills such as:</u> Start taking part in some group activities which they make up themselves, or in teams Choose the right resources to carry out their own plan. E.g. choosing a spade to enlarge a small hole they dug with a trowel Collaborate with others to manage large items, such as moving a long plank safely, carrying large hollow blocks Make healthy choices about food, drink, activity & tooth brushing

Reminders 	<u>Sunscreen</u> - we have had a really hot week, and hopefully the sun will continue to shine, please remember to apply sunscreen daily.

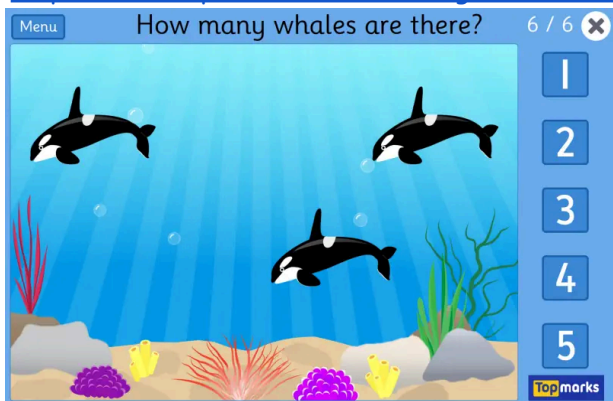
Learning at home
