Maths



Subitising: this is when children can quickly see an amount without counting. Rolling a dice at home is a good way to practise subitising.

Next week we will build towers and we will ask the children to show us with their fingers how many bricks they can see.

Physical Development



Development of ongoing skills such as:

Start taking part in some group activities which they make up themselves, or in teams Choose the right resources to carry out their own plan. E.g. choosing a spade to enlarge a small hole they dug with a trowel

Collaborate with others to manage large items, such as moving a long plank safely, carrying large hollow blocks

Make healthy choices about food, drink, activity & tooth brushing

<u>Sunscreen</u> - we have had a really hot week, and hopefully the sun will continue to shine, please remember to apply sunscreen daily.


Learning at home
