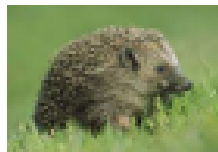
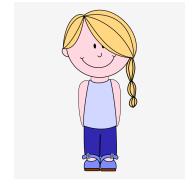

#### At home you can..

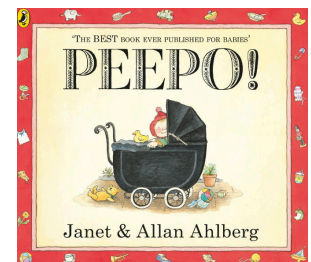
- Discuss the Harvest Celebration

### Maths



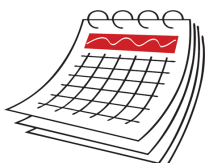
Next week we will explore patterns. We will create patterns with our bodies. For example, stamp, clap, stamp, clap. We will also draw repeating patterns using 2D shapes.


