We have really enjoyed welcoming our grown ups into Nursery this week, we hope you had fun learning with us at school!

Curriculum



We will compare natural objects we have found during our Autumn walk and manmade objects we find in the classroom.

Literacy Communication and Language



We will continue to carry out lots of phonics activities such as going on listening walks and guessing what creature or musical instrument might make the hidden sounds! We will read **The Three Billy Goats Gruff**, joining in with repeated language and acting out the story on our hill in the garden.

Maths



We will think about positional language such as on, in, under, next to. We will take a toy outside and see if we can follow instructions to place the toy on the table, under the slide, next to the sandpit etc.

Physical Development



Development of ongoing skills such as:

Go up steps & stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet
Use one handed tools & equipment, e.g. making snips in paper with scissors
Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils
Continue to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes & bikes) & ball skills.
