Well done on the great cake creations this week! We hope you enjoyed having the opportunity to work with your child and spend some time in Nursery with us.

Curriculum



We will be completing all the Christmas activities we have been working on for the last couple of weeks.

We will learn about food that is healthy and not so healthy for our bodies and our teeth.

Literacy Communication and Language



We will talk about how different families may have the same and different traditions at Christmas. Some children may be able to talk about Christmas experiences they have already had i.e. visiting Santa, putting up their tree, making gingerbread houses.

Maths



We will practise counting up to and back from 5 with Christmas themed songs. We will revise the names of 2D shapes through puzzles and games.

Physical Development



Development of ongoing skills such as:

Go up steps & stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet
Use one handed tools & equipment, e.g. making snips in paper with scissors
Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils
Continue to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes & bikes) & ball skills.
