Curriculum



We will complete some creative activities linked to Bonfire Night.

Literacy Communication and Language



We will find out about everyone's half term through daily news (see the rota below). Please talk to your child about what they have enjoyed doing at home and practise what they would like to say. You are welcome to send in a small item to help them remember or pictures, you can even email photos so we can see them on the big screen.

Maths



We will practise our subitising skills to 3, then 6 and maybe beyond! Subitising means the ability to recognise how many items there are in a group without having to count each item one by one. The children are shown just a glimpse of a small group of items and then they say how many they think there are. This is not only an important numerical skill but it also makes a fun game!

Physical Development



Development of ongoing skills such as:

Go up steps & stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet

Use one handed tools & equipment, e.g. making snips in paper with scissors

Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils

Continue to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes & bikes) & ball skills.
