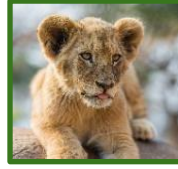

<p>Curriculum</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be remembering and talking about what we did during half term (please see rota below). We will be developing our bug hotel plating the top layer with donated seeds and bulbs
<p>Literacy Communication and Language</p> 	<p>We will read Superworm and think about all the things he was super at dining, and what we are good at doing.</p>
<p>Phonics</p> 	<p>We will think about the sound and letter that starts our name and create a natural collage of our initial.</p> <p>We will continue with phonics activities linked to:</p> 
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>We will focus on repeating patterns and create them with beads, cubes, conkers, cones etc</p>
<p>Physical Development</p> 	<p><u>Development of ongoing skills such as:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Match their developing physical skills to tasks and activities in the setting. E.g. they decide whether to crawl, walk or run across a plank, depending on its length & width Skip, hop, stand on one leg & hold a pose for a game like musical statues Remember sequences and patterns of movements which are related to music and rhythm Be increasingly independent in meeting their own care needs e.g. brushing teeth, using the toilet, washing & drying their hands thoroughly Start to eat independently and learning how to use a knife & fork

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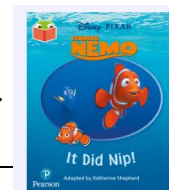
Learning at home
