Curriculum



We will be creating our shopping lists for our upcoming trip to the corner shop. We will also be thinking about how we can keep healthy habits such as eating a balanced diet, doing exercise and cleaning our hair, bodies and teeth.

Literacy Communication and Language



We will read Chocolate Cake by Michael Rosen and practice clapping the syllables in words from the story.

Phonics



We will continue to read this book as a class and practice using our 'robot voices' to sound out the different items we would need for a trip to the beach.



Maths



We will work with numbers to 5 or 6 and keep practising recognising the Numicon pieces for use number.

Physical Development



Development of ongoing skills such as:

- Match their developing physical skills to tasks and activities in the setting. E.g. they decide
 whether to crawl, walk or run across a plank, depending on its length & width
- \bullet $\;$ Skip, hop, stand on one leg & hold a pose for a game like musical statues
- Remember sequences and patterns of movements which are related to music and rhythm
- Be increasingly independent in meeting their own care needs e.g. brushing teeth, using the toilet, washing & drying their hands thoroughly
- Start to eat independently and learning how to use a knife & fork


