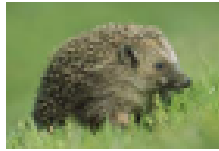

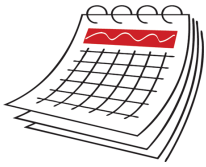
## Build it Up!

<p><b>Curriculum</b></p> 	<p>Next week in Art we will be introducing the children to mono printing. We will be learning about the artist Xgoac'o X'are and using his techniques to create a painting.</p> <p><b>At home you can...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Watch videos on mono printing and have a go at doing one yourself.</li></ul> 
<p><b>English Communication and Language</b></p> 	<p>Next week we will write instructions on how to build a house. First get some bricks. Next build it up. Finally make a roof.</p> <p><u>Phonics:</u></p> <p>In phonics we will write and read words with the digraphs 'ur' and 'ow'. You could practise writing the words: <a href="#">surf</a> <a href="#">turn</a> <a href="#">church</a> <a href="#">cow</a> <a href="#">town</a> .</p> <p><b>At home you can.....</b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● continue to practise writing your phase 3 digraphs</li><li>● practise writing your curly caterpillar letters- <a href="#">c</a> <a href="#">a</a> <a href="#">o</a> <a href="#">g</a> <a href="#">d</a></li></ul>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>In Maths next week we will be exploring capacity and measuring volume. We will use the vocabulary empty, half full and full. We will explore different ways to fill containers including sand and water involving a range of practical activities.</p> <p><b>At home you can...</b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Play with old recycling containers and create your own water area. Try and encourage the key vocabulary such as empty and full.</li></ul>
