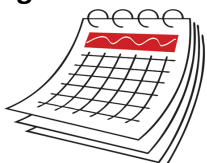
Thursday 6th March - World Book Dress Up Day – Whole School

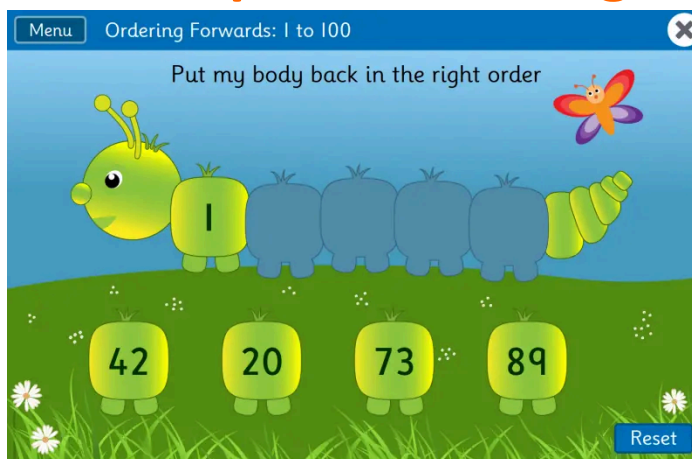
Reminders
